This collection of data on central Pennsylvania families was compiled over a period of many years by Adella Fink Spangler (1871-1964). It was largely assembled from primary documents, a few of which no longer exist. The Spangler Collection is fully

indexed on about 250,000 cards. Among the contents of this collection are:

- Tombstone inscriptions for 113 county cemeteries [updated in a set of modern books by the Centre County Genealogical Society]
- Newspaper obituaries (1826-1854 and 1926-1942)
- Marriage records [updated by a compact disc, indexing Centre County marriages 1764-2005]
- Bible transcriptions
- Church records
- Family records
- Tax lists

J. Marvin Lee Genealogical Collection:

A good adjunct to the Spangler Collection for the early to mid-twentieth century, this grouping contains approximately 20 notebooks compiled by a longtime Centre County genealogist/historian. Mr. Lee's work, which includes family group sheets with some documentation, is primarily from the 1940s to the 1970s.
