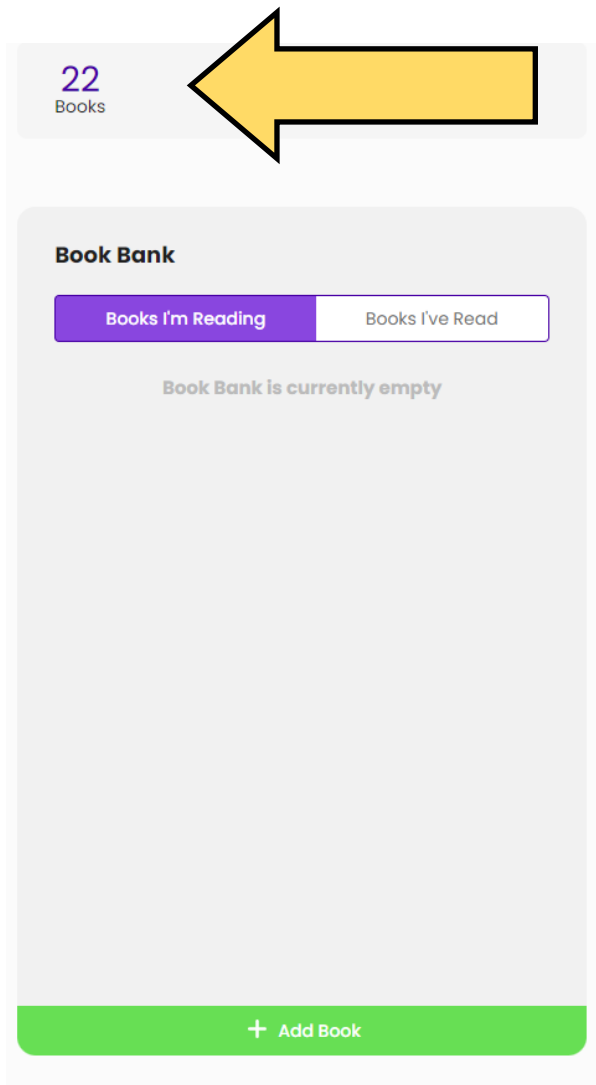


To Log Books read into the Reading Entry and Total Activity on a desktop:



1. After selecting your reader's 1,000 Books Before Kindergarten account, You will land in your dashboard.

On the right side you will see your Book Bank and your running book count progress.

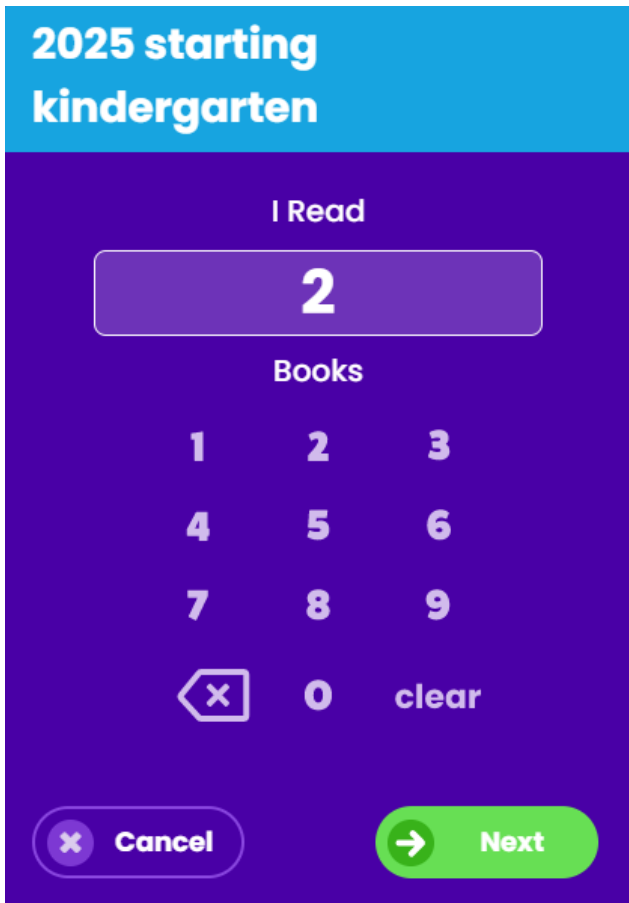
2. To add books to your running progress total Select "Add Reading Entry" to add an entry for today.

3. If you would like to go back and add entries for past days, click "Add Past Entry" below your book bank (it is not necessary for you to add books on the exact day that you read them).

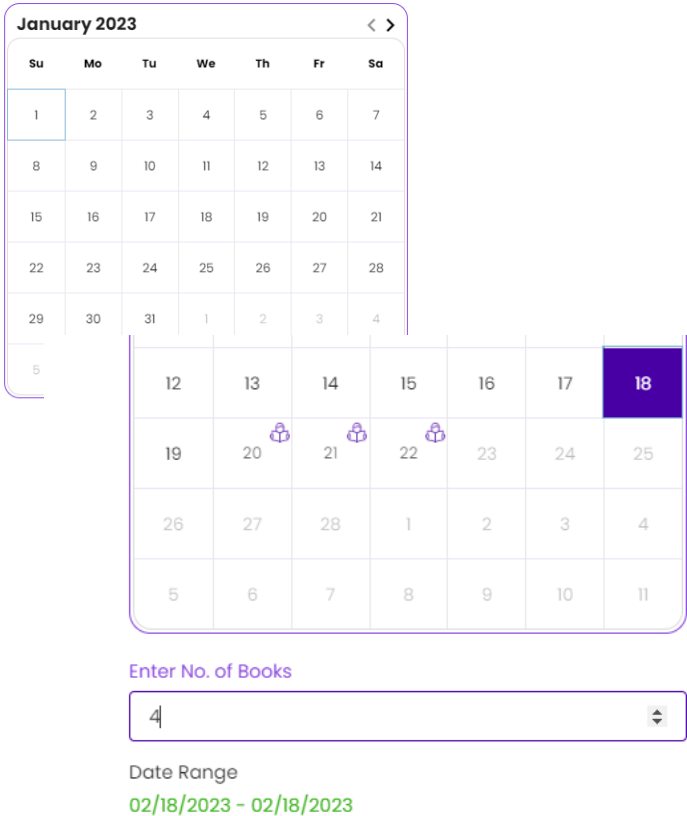

4. If you are adding a new entry you will be prompted with this pop-up where you will enter your total books read that you want to add to your running progress total.
5. Click Next.

Add a Past Entry

Make an entry for one day or a range of days. For one day, double click the date. For more than one day, click the first and last day for which you want to make entries. Entries can be edited at any time.



6. If you click the “Add Past Entry” button you will see this pop-up calendar.
7. Select the day that you want to add books for (again, this information is not necessary to be accurate.) *you may need to click the date twice.
8. Then add your total for the day
9. Then click “Add”
